Rates

While it's not possible to create an exact price sheet because of all the variables from site to site, this will at least give you a price range. Please call to discuss your needs and I would be happy to provide a firm quote.

Website design, development and posting typically costs from \$80-150.00 per page. The lower end of this scale would be a very basic web page designed around a supplied logo or other artwork, copy/paste text and maybe an email link. At the higher end of the scale your page(s) might include custom design work, photo and some video editing, multiple email and/or links, basic flash or other animation, audio, etc. Again...call with your needs and I will be happy to tell you more about my work and provide exact prices.

I charge \$50.00/hour for any work over and above the web services listed above. This can include excessive photo/video editing, research, e-commerce, the addition of blogs, formmail, etc. I can also develop business cards, letterheads, envelopes and brochures to match and compliment your site.

While you are more than welcome to use your own hosting service, I do provide this service to my clients for an annual fee of \$40.00 (subject to change but it hasn't yet).

The third thing we need to get your website complete, along with your hosting and site files, is a registered domain. This is the www.your_site.com name that you type into your browser address bar to find your site. If you do not yet have a domain and need help setting that up, please call and I can help you with that, also.

What I need from you is any artwork and/or photos, text that can be copied/pasted and any ideas you may already have as to what you want your site to look like. You can also supply me links to sites you like and want to base your site on. Or if you want, you can let me put a few ideas together based on your logo, tastes or other factors and we take it from there. Sometimes these things fly and sometimes they crash and burn...it's all part of the creative process! My goal here is to give you a site with the content you need coupled with the look you want.
